



Some of the exciting activities we have ready for you!

- Team-Building – Test your team work skills on our team-building course with 9 separate challenges set out for you. They each challenge you, physically and mentally, to work out the best way to get to the finish but one thing's for sure – you'll have to work with others to get there!
- Zip-Lines – Our 45 metre double zip-line will give your children an exhilarating experience as they fly through the air side by side with a classmate.
- Climbing Arena – Your children can traverse the walls offering varied difficulty levels and boulder on our purpose built rocks.
- Crossbows – Take aim and shoot with our crossbows and target boards.
- Orienteering & Exploring – A series of games that help you children build their mapping and navigation skills for the main event - the Star and Score Events. Challenge your children to find over 50 control markers set about the site, developing independence from adult support and interdependence with peers, and all while having a lot of fun.
- Animal Trail – Set in the brand new 100 Year Woods, there are animals hiding in the trees waiting for you to find them. If you do you'll have to work out which cryptic clue relates to them on the Animal Trail Challenge sheet.
- Fairy Trail - Also set in the brand new 100 Year Woods, take a walk along the paths looking for the fairy doors – some harder to find than others. You might even discover a fairy village if you're looking closely enough!
- Quidditch – This fun game, inspired by the Harry Potter films includes capes, broomsticks, quaffles, bludgers and the golden snitch!
- Pond Dipping – Head down to our large pond/small lake at the southern end of site. Resources include large and small nets, trays, ident sheets and a number of other useful pieces of equipment. There is a dedicated pond dipping platform. While you're down we'll take a walk along the Circular Pond Path passing by the bluebell woods.
- Grass Sledging – Hurtle down the activity field on purpose built tracked sledges.
- Butterfly Netting & the Butterfly Maze – chase after butterflies in butterfly meadow with our butterfly nets so you can humanely get a close look and identify which species they are. They complete the challenges within our living Butterfly Maze.
- Den-building – Build your own camp in our woods using what nature has to offer or a combination of nature's resources and our tarps, bungees, rope and pegs.
- Night-lining – Follow the ropes and complete the obstacle course. Sounds easy except I forgot to say you'll be blind-folded!
- Nature Crafts – How about using nature to create art doing some Hapa Zome – you get to bash things with hammers and create art! And, as if that wasn't enough, how about an Andy Goldsworthy challenge!
- Playing in the Woods – Sometimes simple is best! Play hide and seek, hang out in hammocks or swing on our tyre swings!
- Outdoor Movie Experience – Our woodland shelter, the Hive, turns into a movie theatre. We'll even provide the popcorn!
